

FWP Announces Suspension of Non-resident Restrictions for Black Bear and Turkey

MOGA's work with the Governor's office, and FWP has aided in the decision to lift suspension of the non-resident black bear and turkey seasons in Montana effective April 24. Licenses will again be available for purchase on line.

The re-opening follows the Governor's announcement of Phase 1 and Phase II which opened the state to outfitted services effective on Monday April 27. Under Phase 1 and 2 of the Governor's directive, guides and outfitters may offer services consistent with any ongoing quarantine travel restrictions provided they adhere to social distancing guidelines and sanitation protocols. Visitors should check the status of any closures and restrictions before traveling.

We strongly encourage Outfitters providing services to do so under the protocols suggested by MOGA and take specific steps to ensure the safety of their clients, staff and communities.
